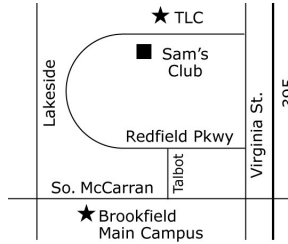
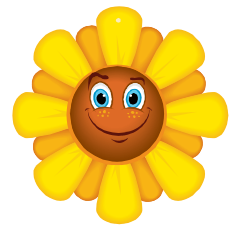
- ☀ **Art with Math** - We will learn different math concepts through projects, using art and other interactive activities. Students will be given the opportunity to create great works of art. Symmetry, % or ratios, geometry are just a few concepts used in art every day! Enjoy with Mrs. Bratt or Mr. T.
- ☀ **American Sign Language** - We will learn all the basics of signing. Learn to communicate with out any sound with Ms. Naaz.
- ☀ **Dance, Dance, Dance** will also be taught by Mrs. Conkey. This class emphasizes high energy, creativity and fun! Students will lean the basic steps from a variety of dance styles that will include: Hip Hop, Irish Dance, Jazz and Musical Theatre Dance! Dancers will experience the joy of movement through rhythmic challenges, choreographic exploration, improvisation and performance combination. The aim of this class is to promote physical self awareness, self confidence and exercise.
- ☀ **FIT / FOOD / FUN** – Identify food and fitness for healthy living. Make informed and healthy choices on what you eat. Understand the issues on fast food and processed foods. Create exercise goals, menus, and cook or build great snacks. Enjoy with Ms. Brugman or Mr. T.
- ☀ **Hello New Writer** – Focus on making a story from the beginning to the end with Mrs. Bratt! Learn about making characters, plot and the resolution of the story. Each student will have a finished piece to share with others. If we have time we may even design a cover and a few illustrations to go with our stories.
- ☀ **Kids C S I Science Investigators** – Science for all ages. Hands-on! Enjoy with Mrs. Bratt or Mr. T.
- ☀ **Make My Book** - We will have all sorts of fun and make a *Personal Book* through photography, writing, and art projects. Our fantastic Ms. Brugman or Mrs. Blackstock will be teaching this class.
- ☀ **My Store** - Economics 101 for kids. Learn how to save, spend, purchase and stock inventory. Kids will run a store for the other summer campers. Benefits of a strong financial background can last a lifetime. This class may be taught by Mr. T or Ms. Hinkel.
- ☀ **Outdoor Sports** - Students will learn the basics of sports such as soccer, basketball, baseball and football. We will learn skills and techniques in a playful, non-competitive way. This class will be taught by Mr. Trevino, Ms. Brugman, or Miss Jay.
- ☀ **Playful Performances** - is a merging of art, music, and performing arts, producing a mini performance each week, and it is taught by our very talented Mrs. Conkey. Mask making, costuming, movie scripts, stage make-up, pantomime, improvisation games, and set design each play a role in Playful Performances. Many aspects of dramatic theatre will be explored alongside rehearsing a weekly fun play taking students from the 'Rainforest' to 'Outer Space.' Students will perform every Friday.
- ☀ **Puppet Play Craziiness/Arts and Crafts** –creating puppets and puppet plays with Mrs. Lillegard, Mrs. Conkey, or Ms. Hinkel. We will design a large variety of puppets such as: string puppets, finger puppets, and hand puppets. Puppets will be made from paper, cloth, socks, and bags! A large box, a curtain and some tables will be transformed into puppet play craziness land! Imagination is required to participate in this class!
- ☀ **Rock Hounds of Nevada** – Discover why our state is famous for its rocks and minerals. Visit a rock museum. Pan for gold. Study geology and rock hunting is a great summer filled with fun! Enjoy this class with Mr. T or Mrs. Blackstock.
- ☀ **Tie Me Up With Knitting & Yarn** - This course will be taught by Mrs. Blackstock or Mrs. Brugman. Learn how to cast on and bind off stitches. Learn the basic knit and pearl stitch. Make a pot holder and a scarf. These basics will allow you to knit anything – from a blanket to a sweater!
